Writing down and publishing science is just as important as the science itself. However, many researchers struggle to carve out the relevant material, are afraid of writing, feel demotivated by seemingly endless cycles of drafting, writing, reviewing, revising, or their submitted articles get rejected.

The course “Writing Scientific Papers” is a 2-day interactive workshop. It targets PhD students, Postdocs and researchers that wish to kick-start or improve their skills for writing papers, targeting the entire process from paper-oriented research to final publication.

Participants are asked to bring electronic copies of their manuscripts (if available) for hands-on exercises with their own material.
